You will receive a recipe sheet which makes approximately 30 days supply of balancer for your pony. It states the scoops of each ingredient, which you then mix up to make your balancer for the month. I advise making one month at a time in case there is anything that you need to adjust or add.

Introduce your new balancer slowly, and make sure that you seek advice from your vet before making dietary changes. As the supplements are powders, fussy horses may need a little tweaking to make the formula more palatable. I often use cinnamon powder to make supplements more appealing, and the carrier feed that I use is Spillers Ready Fibre Mash, which is apple scented. My ponies love it!

Most horses are kept differently in the winter to the summer, so it may be a good idea to get a formula for each to ensure proper nutrition. For example, my ponies live out all year round, but they are fed hay in winter. The change in forage and grass quality means that they need extra vitamin e, and a few other little adjustments.
